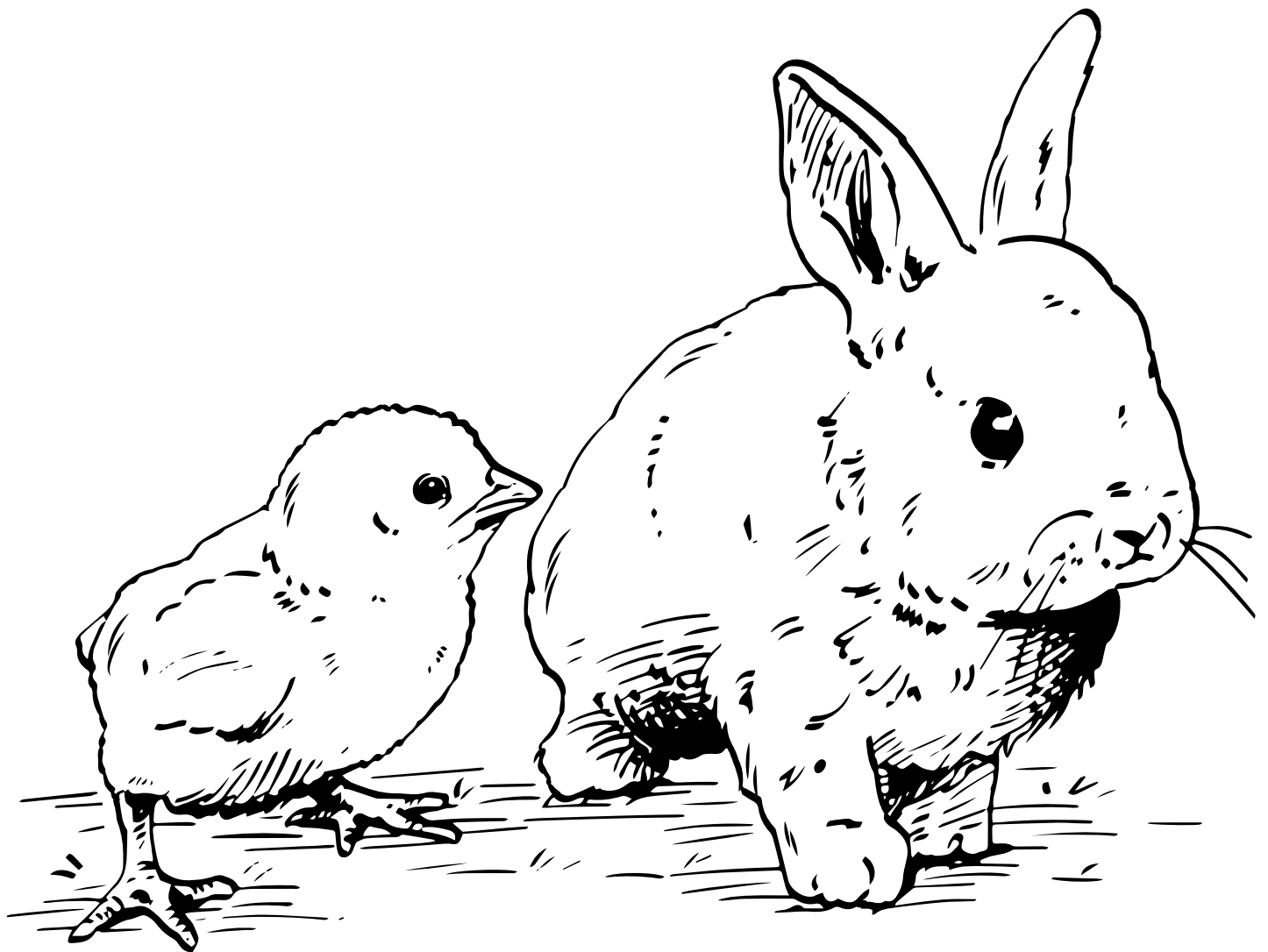

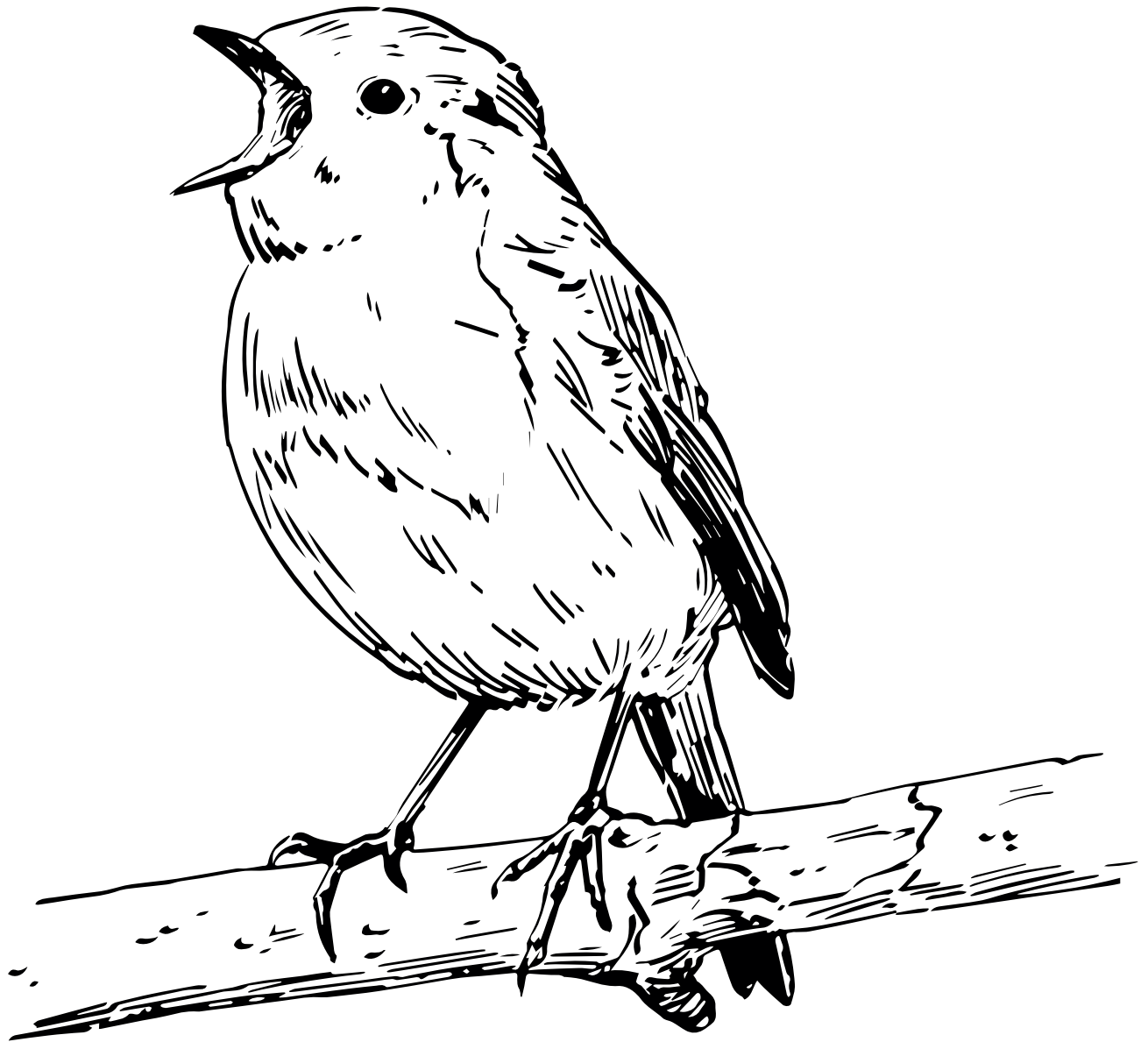
# ANIMALS

Magnificent red stags roam the moorland of Mar Lodge Estate National Nature Reserve near Braemar.



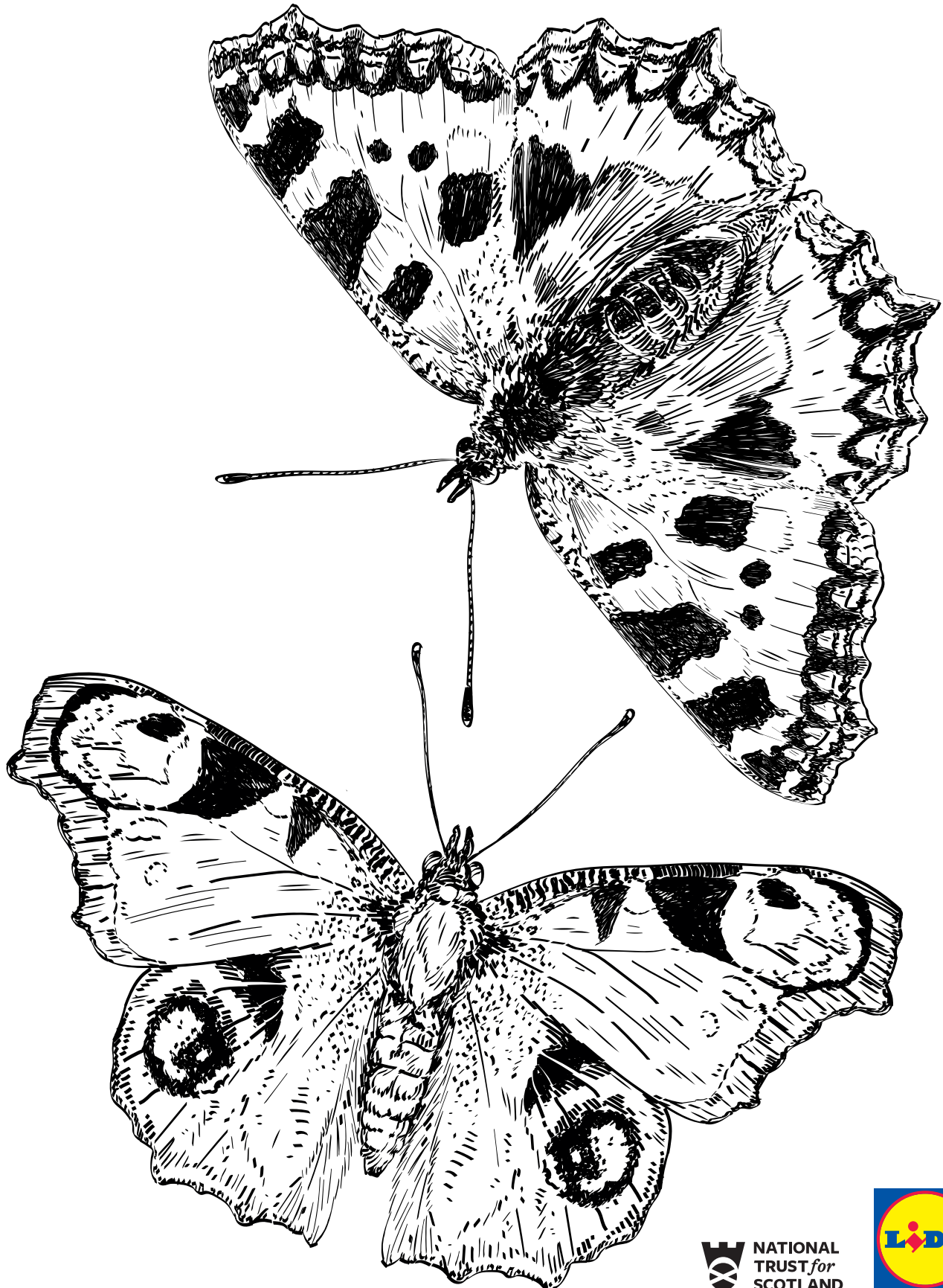
# BIRDS

St Abb's Head National Nature Reserve in the Scottish Borders has bluebells and primroses galore.



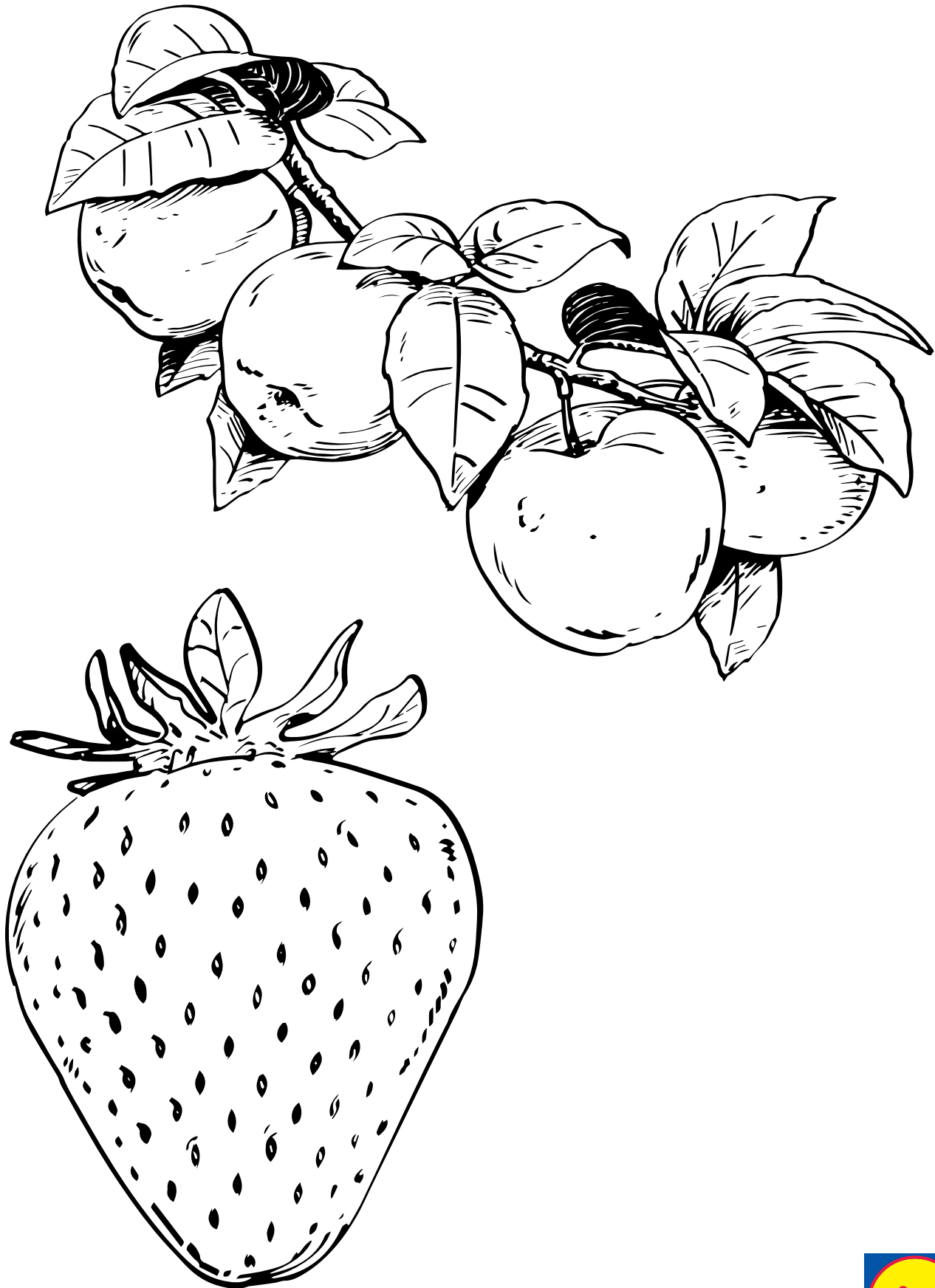
# FLOWERS
