- **9.** Explain why young people were not taught by disaffected or rebellious people.

## **Glossary**:

**Disaffected** = dissatisfied, especially with people in authority or a system of control

Custody = imprisonment

**Detained** = keeping someone or something back (sometimes in jail)

**Pretence** = an attempt to make something that is not the case appear true

**Garb** = clothing

**Episcopalian** = religious group

**Disarming** = taking weapons away (usually banned)

**Plantation** = an estate on which crops such as coffee, sugar, and tobacco are grown

**Successors** = a person or thing that takes over from someone/ something else

**Heirs** = a person legally entitled to the property or rank of another on that person's death

**Exempt** = free from restrictions
