Set on one of the most significant battlefields in British history, Culloden provides a powerful and thought-provoking backdrop that adds meaning and impact to any occasion. Guests can enjoy exclusive, out-of-hours access to our award-winning visitor centre, including private tours of the interactive exhibition and the dramatic 360-degree battle immersion experience. The rooftop viewing platform also offers striking views across the moor, providing a quiet moment for reflection or a memorable setting for informal networking.
