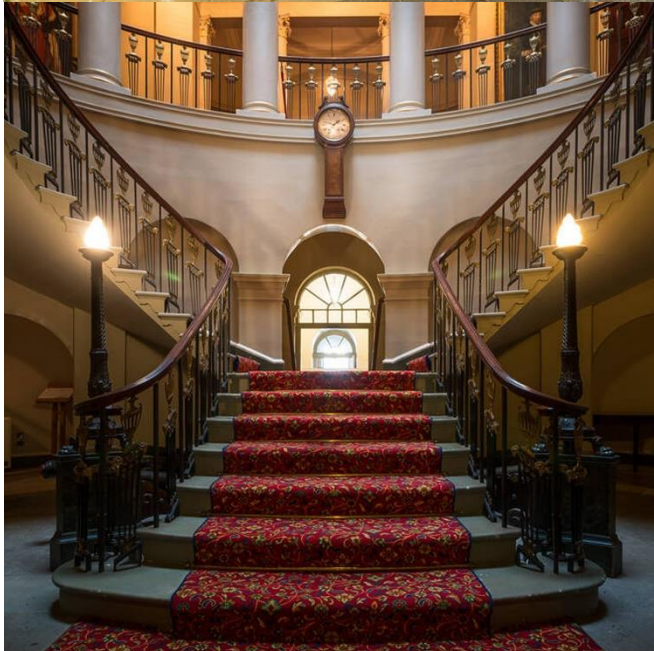




What's on for Schools 2023

Outdoor Learning

Outdoor Learning

Plastic Not Fantastic

Duration: 90 mins

A shoreline scavenger hunt investigating the effects of marine litter of a coastal habitat. Pupils will explore ways of reducing marine plastics and will be encouraged to adopt a respectful and caring attitude towards the natural world.



How to Book

All visits must be booked in advance, including self-led visits to the country park. To make a booking please email Culzean@nts.org.uk

All bookings must be made a minimum of 21 days in advance and paid no later than 14 days prior to your visit. Payment may be made in advance via telephone using a valid debit/credit card. (Excluding American Express) or by cheque, payable to the National Trust for Scotland.

If payment is not received 14 days prior to your visit, we may cancel your booking.

If you wish to visit sooner, please call 01655 884455 to see if we can accommodate your booking.

Cancellations

For any cancellations we will require at least 7 days' notice to provide you with a full refund, if cancelled out with 7 days' notice we will be unable to provide a refund for your visit.
