Culzean Castle and Country Park is a fantastic setting for a fun and educational school visit. With our historic Castle, stunning gardens, woodland trails, and a playpark full of adventure, there's something for every young explorer to enjoy.

Whether your pupils are learning about history, exploring nature, or just making the most of the outdoors, Culzean is full of exciting opportunities to see, do, and discover. This is a cross-curricular learning experience you can adapt to suit your own class .

On a self-led visit, your class can explore the Castle, gardens, woodland, and beach at your own pace. Discover the history of the castle, spot wildlife in the park, and enjoy the adventure play area. It's a great way to support learning in a relaxed, outdoor setting.

If you'd like to include a visit inside the castle, please note that timed entry slots are required. Inside, pupils can discover the history of the Castle and its former residents.

Will your class pond dip, go rock pooling or learn about lifecycles? Let us know which area you would like to cover.



## Outdoor Learning

### Plastic Not Fantastic

Duration: 90 mins

A shoreline scavenger hunt investigating the effects of marine litter of a coastal habitat. Pupils will explore ways of reducing marine plastics and will be encouraged to adopt a respectful and caring attitude towards the natural world.
