Arrive at Glenfinnan's historic railway station for the Station Museum, Dining Car & Sleeping Car.

Walk to the Railway Viaduct along a panoramic hillside path (20 min) ~ Continue to NTS Visitor Centre (15 min) ~ Walk from NTS Visitor Centre to Railway Station on the pavement (15 min)
