Halloween haunting at Hill of Tarvit

This Halloween, the National Trust for Scotland's Hill of Tarvit Mansion has a lineup of frightfully spooky events.

On Saturday, 26 October the weekend's Halloween events programme kicks off with the mansion's popular Ghost Tours. There will be two time slots, the first suitable for children and the second, taking place after dark, especially for adults. Visitors will meet the roaming spirits of the Hill of Tarvit who only show themselves at Halloween and those attending are advised to prepare themselves for scary encounters!

Following the Ghost Tours, on Monday 28 October, the Hill of Tarvit Mansion will transform in the Abandon Hope Hotel, for its murder mystery evening - Fright Night at the Hotel.

Fright Night at the Hotel, will be performed by Can You Catch the Killer? a group of performers specialising in Murder Mystery Events, mixing live game play with high quality theatrical performances.

A murder will be discovered at the end of the first act after which, guests will be tasked with solving the mystery of whodunnit.

The Fright Night murder mystery evening is suitable for all ages, but for maximum enjoyment the organiser recommends it for children aged 10+. Included in the ticket price are sharing platters consisting of main course and desert.
