Music returns to the National Trust for Scotland's Hill of Tarvit Mansion this Spring with an unusual Easter concert which combines period music and storytelling.

Music Through Time is a one-off concert taking place at the Hill of Tarvit on 21 April performed by Jim Tribble. Jim, a multi-instrumentalist and story teller, has performed across Europe for over 30 years.

Music Through Time will take you on a musical journey of the 16th Century and involves a mixture of instrumental pieces played on period instruments, interspersed with amusing and interesting observations about those instruments and the music they play.
