As one of Scotland's largest tower houses, the castle provides a haunting setting for a spooky after-dark tour. Away from the lavish life of the Fraser family, hidden trapdoors, narrow staircases and spy holes hint at a secretive life within the castle, which will be uncovered on the tour.

Frightfully fun for the whole family, the ghostly guided tour will take guests through the cobweb filled and candle-lit castle, revealing this darker past with gruesome tales and ghost stories.

The Spooky Tour lasts one hour and advance booking is recommended. Tickets are priced at £15 per adult and £6 per child.
