Concert series continues at Hill of Tarvit

Music at the Mansion at the National Trust for Scotland's Hill of Tarvit has become a regular feature on the Fife events scene, and the series continues with a Midsummer Night's Concert.

On 21 June a Midsummer Night's Concert will be coming to the Hill of Tarvit Mansion. The concert will be performed by Fiona Mackenzie, one of Scotland's top vocalists, regularly singing all over Scotland and will feature popular music from the 1920s and 30s, a period, when the Sharp family – previous occupants of the mansion – entertained their guests in the house and grounds. The repertoire will be varied and includes some classics of the time such as 'It's only a paper moon', 'Stormy weather', 'Diamonds are a girl's best friend', 'Summertime', 'Mack the knife', 'Cheek to cheek' and many more.

Geraldine Graf Hospitality and Events Manager at the Hill of Tarvit said: "We're thrilled to welcome Fiona to Hill of Tarvit as we play host to the type of music, which would have been played at the mansion when the Sharp family entertained their guests. This concert promises to bring bringing the mansion and its history, to life"

The concert will take place either in the atmospheric Great Hall at Hill of Tarvit Mansion or (weather permitting) on the front terrace overlooking the gardens and grounds.
