Perched on the Ayrshire cliffs, near the town of Maybole, Culzean Castle boasts thick woods to play in, beaches to run along, two amazing playparks and a massive 260-hectare estate bursting with wildlife.

Splish Splash Splosh will give nature hungry kids the chance to discover the creatures hiding in Culzean's rock pools, get creative with natural materials, make cool art, and even sand paint on the beach. There will even be some fantastic beach games to round off the summer fun!

Make sure to wear weather appropriate clothing and don't forget wellies for all the splashing on the day! A packed lunch and backpack is also essential.

The full day of activities costs just £10.50 per child and will last from 10:30am to 3:30pm. Booking is required for this event which is most suited to children aged 7-12-yrs.
