What's On – Holy Bat Walk, Batman: Discover the Hidden Life of Flying Mammals at Barry Mill

Visit the National Trust for Scotland's Barry Mill this August to discover the truth behind the animal that inspired one of the world's greatest superheroes.

Venture out into the darkness, armed only with a torch, to hunt for bats in their natural habitat. Using bat detectors, you'll attempt to locate and observe bats in flight, seeing and hearing how they hunt their prey.

Along the way, you'll discover why these flying mammals are such important indicator species, and debunk some of the myths and legends that surround them.
