What's On - Discover the Birds of Fyvie Loch at Fyvie Castle this Summer

Join the National Trust for Scotland rangers on a journey of discovery at Fyvie Castle, uncovering the amazing wildlife that calls its loch home.

Meet the ducks and swans that live on Fyvie Loch, while learning how to properly use binoculars and telescopes to view them from safe distance. If you're lucky, you'll see chicks taking their first trips out onto the water - along with some of the rarer birds that live in the area, including herons and moorhens.

The rangers will also explain how the birds of Fyvie Loch build their nests, before leading a session of games and crafts suitable for children aged 5-11 and their families.
