

GO BATTY!

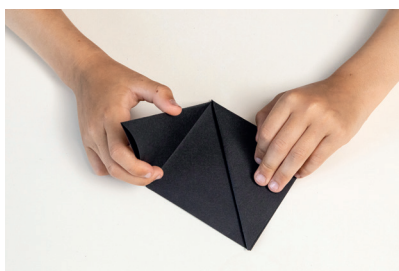
These origami bookmarks are fun and easy to make

- You will need:
- Two squares of black paper
 - Scissors
 - Glue
 - White paper

1 With adult help, cut two wing shapes from one sheet of black paper, then set aside. Fold the other sheet in half diagonally.



2 With the fold facing you, bring the right corner up to meet the top corner. Do the same with the left. Then unfold them both, leaving creases.



3 Flip down the top sheet so its top point hits the central fold, then crease in place. Fold the sides back along their creases and tuck them in.

4 You've now created a pocket to sit on the corner of your book. Glue on the bat wings and use white paper for eyes and teeth.



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
