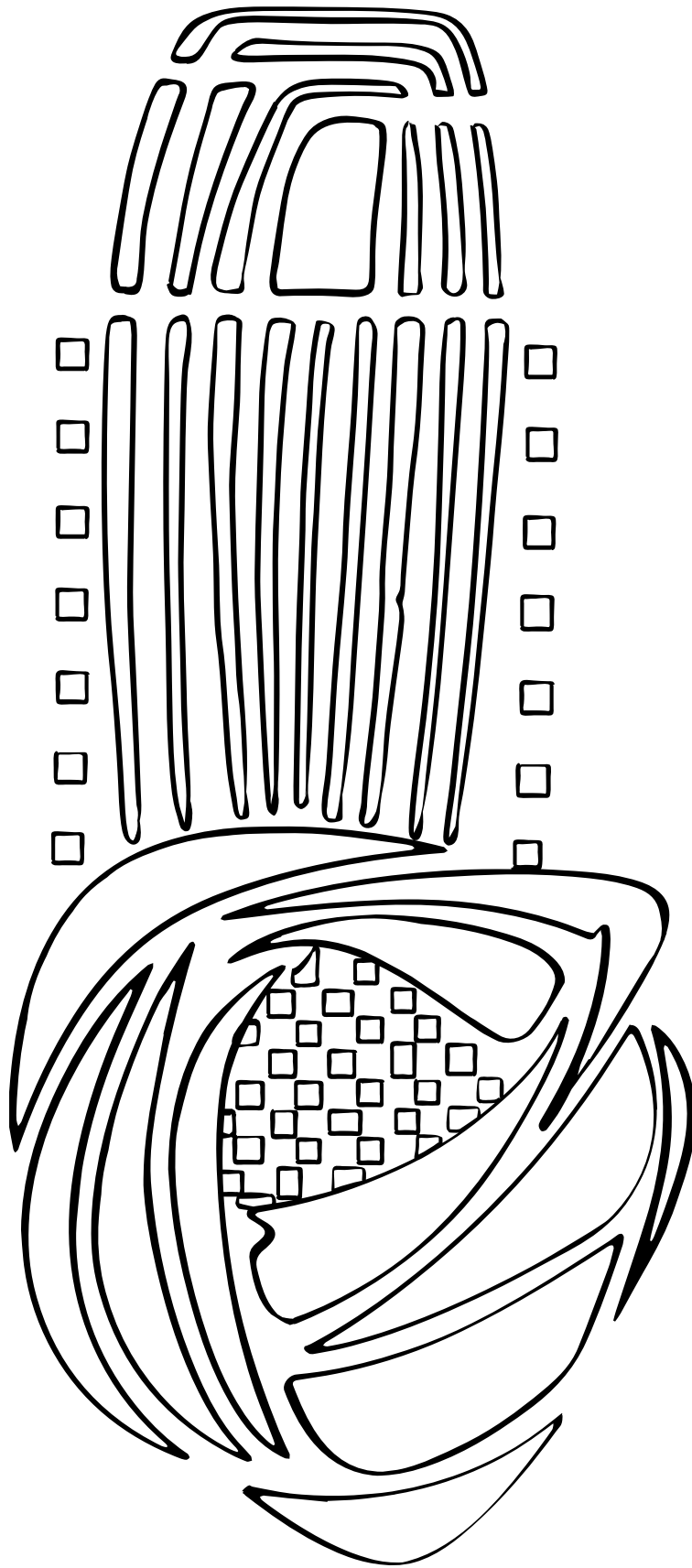


PATTERNS

Architect and designer Charles Rennie Mackintosh created this botanical motif.

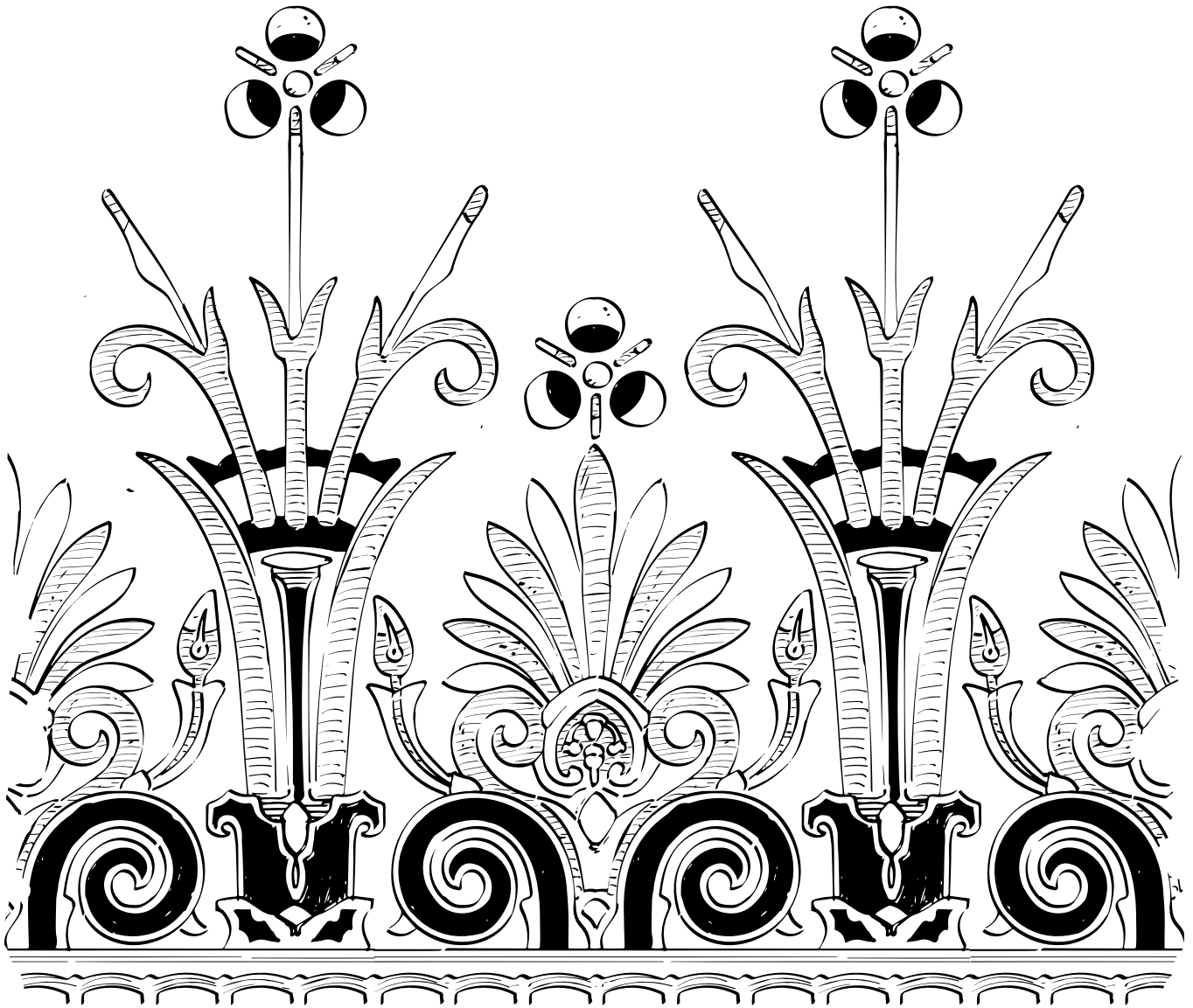

Glasgow's Holmwood is one of the best examples of Alexander 'Greek' Thomson's work.



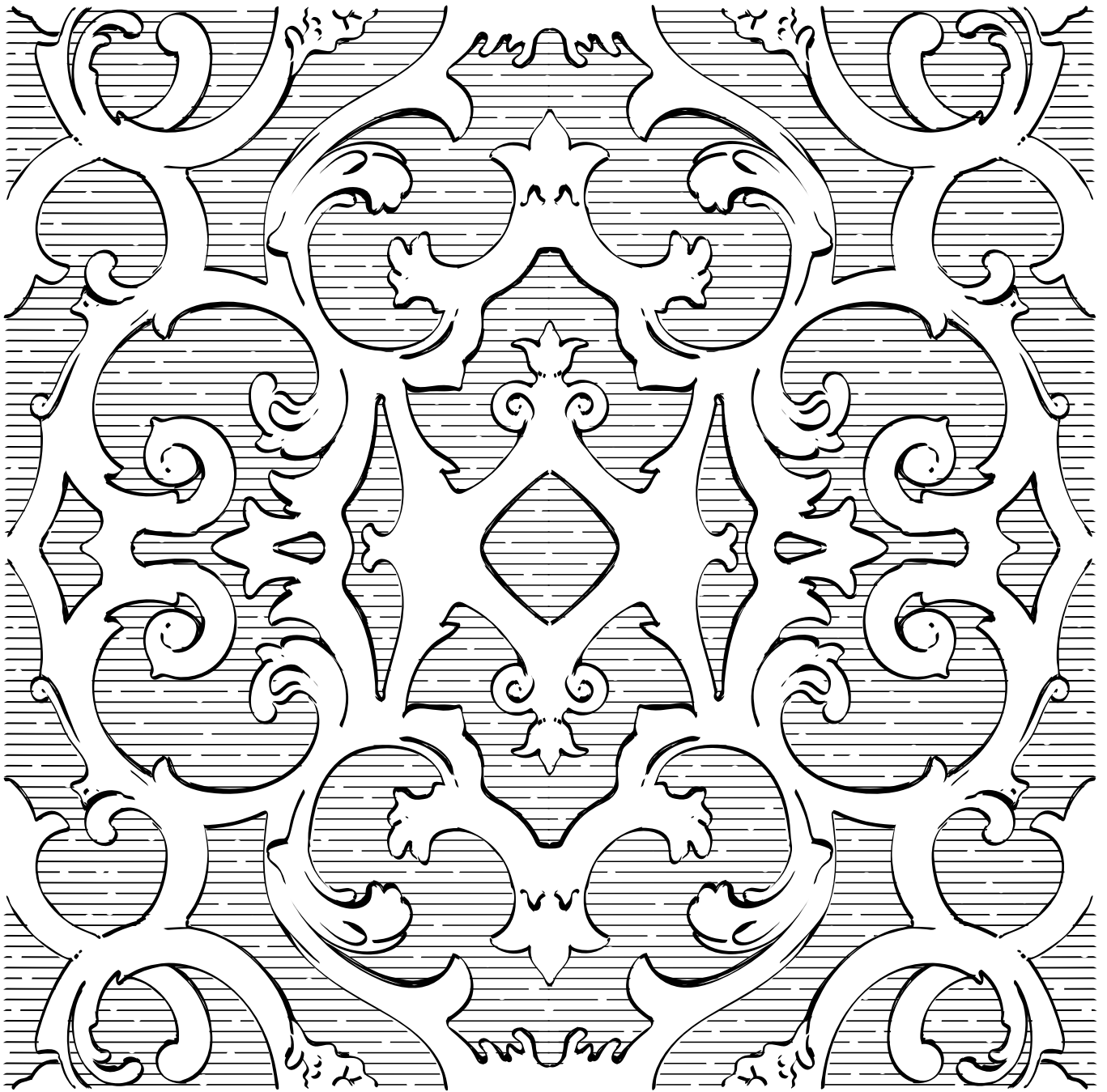

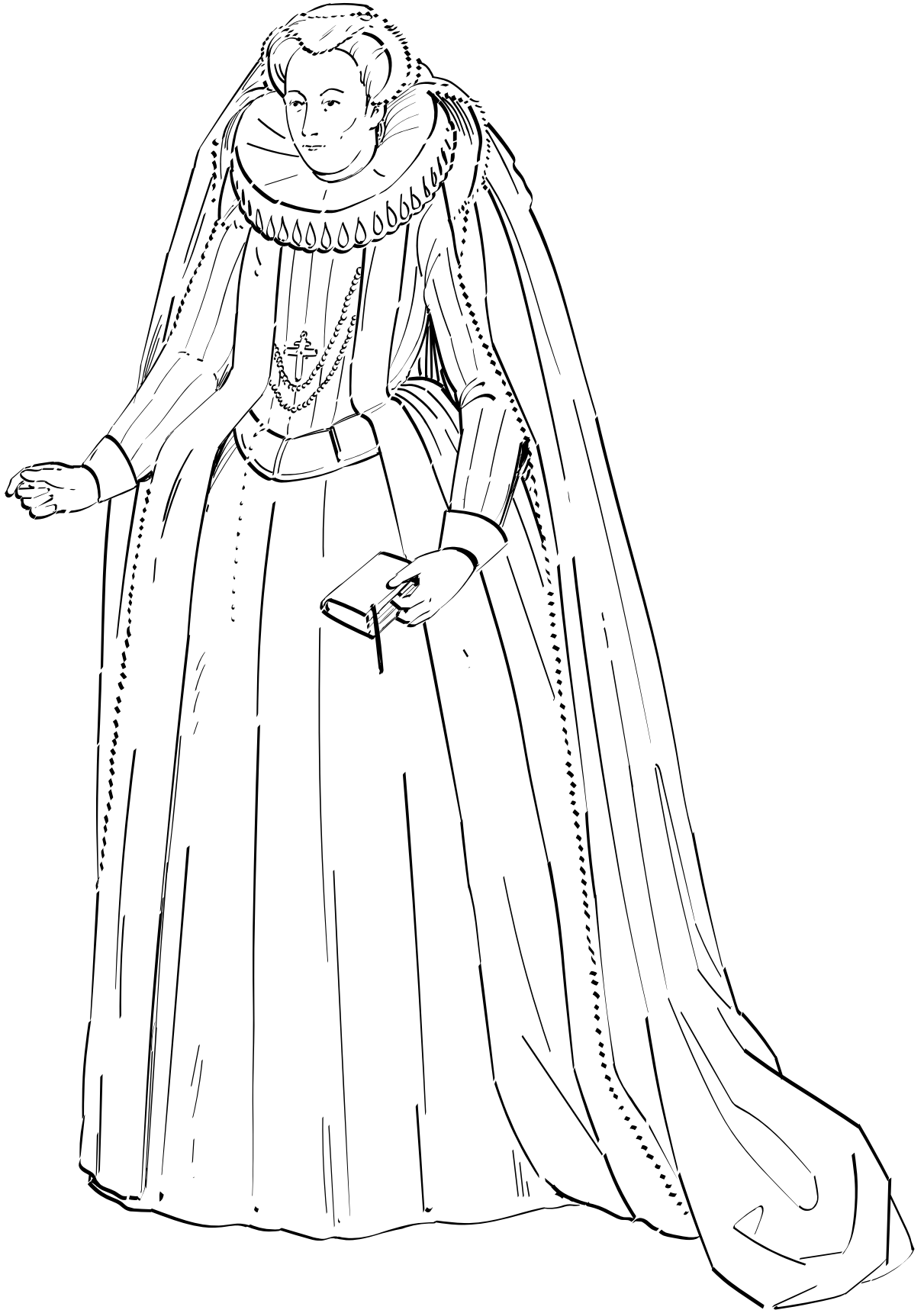

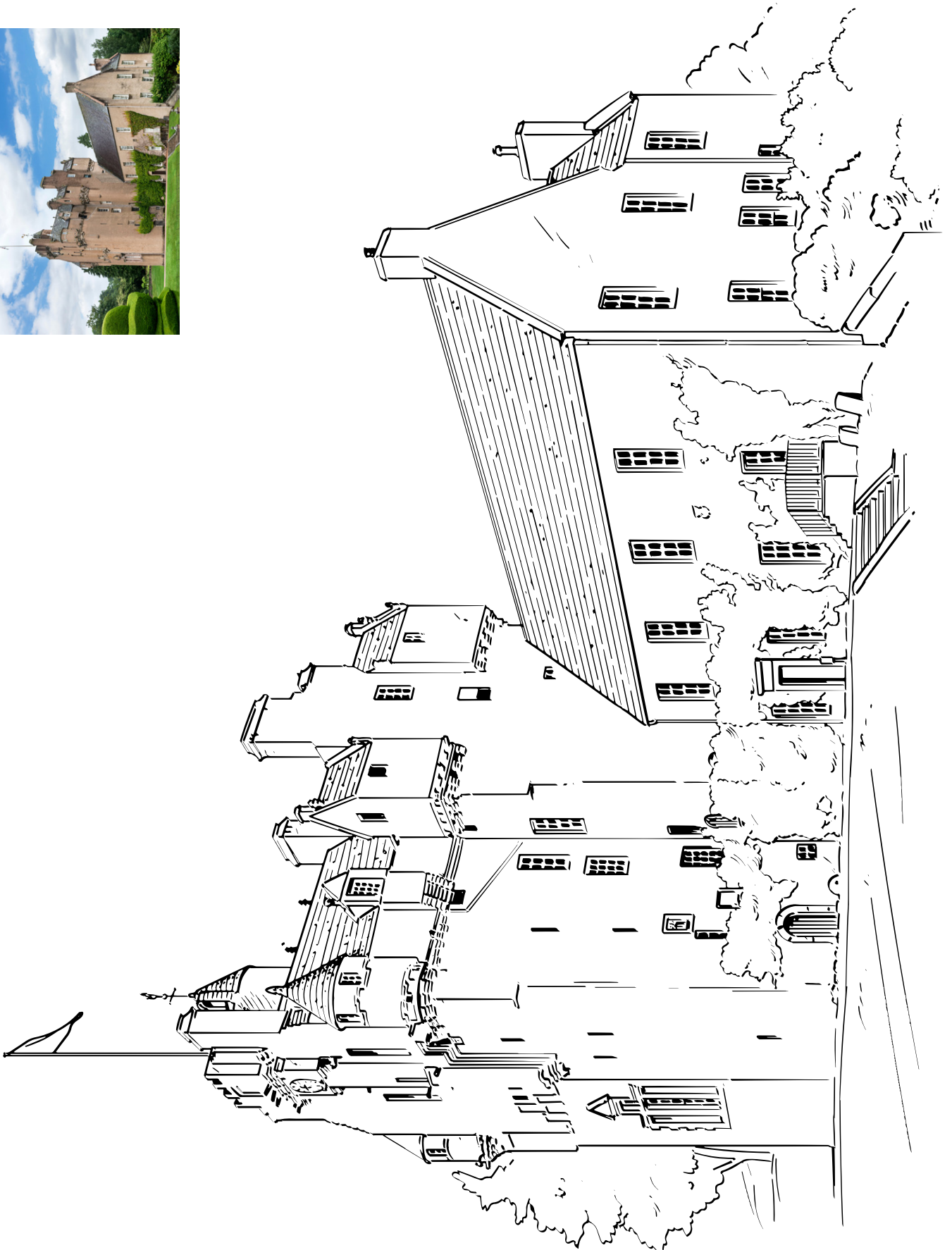

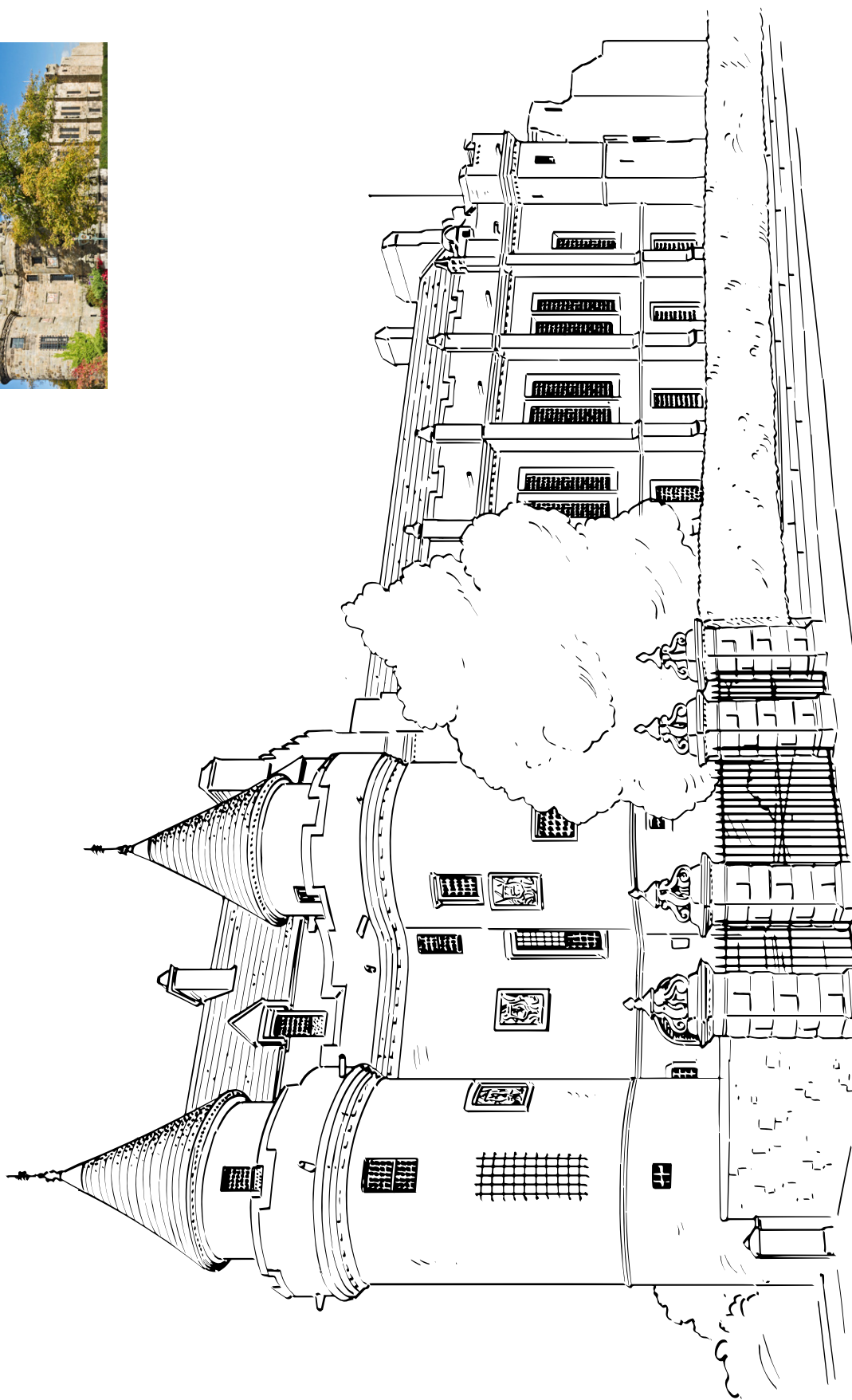
